An industrial lecture on "Role of livestock on food and nutrition security" has been delivered by Prof. Dr. Md. Ali Akbar, Vice Chancellor, Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU), Mymensingh on 27 April 2017 at the Faculty of Agro-Based Industry (FIAT), Universiti Malaysia Kelantan (UMK), Jeli Campus. At the beginning of his lecture he has focused the Bangladesh Agricultural University describing the number of faculties institutes, centers, farms etc. available in the university, the programs offered and the research facilities available. The students of SBH3 group and lecturers of two faculties of UMK, FIAT and FSB participated in the talk. Prof. Ali Akbar has discussed the scenario of world population growth and its relationship with the food security, especially in the developing countries. Then he has described, in his 30 minutes talk, the contribution of livestock products in solving the problems of food insecurity How quality protein from meat, milk, eggs and other products can ensure the food safety and security, he added. Questions were asked to the speaker by the students about the utilization of livestock wastes and method of improving fodder production, which were answered properly by the speaker. After finishing his lecture, Prof. Ali Akbar has discussed about the progress in initiation of MOU between UMK and BAU, he made with the Vice Chancellor of UMK on 26 April at UMK city campus, Kota Bharu. Finally, Dr. Fatimah Kayat, the acting Dean of FIAT has presented a souvenir from the Faculty to the guest speaker.
